



## ROSARY STABLES BARN POLICIES

All riders, boarders, lease holders, students and guests :

Boarders are responsible for ensuring their guests and lease holders abide by all the stable rules and accepting responsibility for the conduct of all guests and invitees according to these rules. The following list of rules is to be read and followed. Any boarder who fails to comply with any of the rules on this list will be subject to immediate termination of privileges at the sole discretion of the management.

### RIDERS AND VISITORS

- Stable hours : 6.am to 10pm 7 days a week.
- A signed Boarding Agreement, Signed Lease or a signed Release Form is required prior to riding anywhere on the premises.
- Drugs are not permitted in any form; Smoking is PROHIBITED.
- If you open it, close it. If you turn it on, turn it off. If you take it out, put it back.
- Clean up after your horse (manure, mud/dirt in wash racks, hair, hoof trimming and nails). Please dispose of all waste in the designated areas.
- Helmets are required while mounted for all guests as well as minors at anytime they are around a horse. Riding apparel & equipment are the responsibility of the rider.
- Please report any broken/damaged items to the barn owners so repairs can be handled quickly
- Do not give treats to any horse other than your own.
- Out of courtesy to our neighbors and to help ensure the safety of both horse and rider do not ride on neighbors properties.

### STALL BARN

- Turn off the light and fans when you leave
- Tack room must remain neat and organized : be respectful that multiple people share the same area. Keep horse treats/feed in metal or hard plastic containers. Otherwise it will attract mice.
- Do not leave horses unattended in cross ties, wash racks or any common area including arenas

### IN DOOR ARENA

- Respect others and clean up after your horse in the arena
- Remove any trainings equipment and jumps from arena after you are done your ride and store in designated areas
- Do not tie horses in the indoor arena.

- Do not groom horses or tack them up in the indoor.
- Say "door" when entering or exiting the barn.
- One person lounging at a time if there are riders in the arena. Ask other riders if it is alright to lounge. Lounging only allowed if it does not interfere with the other riders.
- Arena areas should be shared. Please use proper ring etiquette and be courteous of other riders entering, exiting, and using the arena. Always ride in control and be aware of others riding around you.

#### DURING TRAIL RIDE IN ROSARYVILLE STATE PARK:

- Riders must stay on designated/ marked trail
- No smoking on the trail
- Carry a cell phone on your body to use in case of an emergency
- Avoid muddy trails
- Obey all signage – do not ride in non-horse areas
- It is best not to ride alone.
- Good riding etiquette prevents land abuse and destruction

#### GENERAL:

- Any type of inhumane treatment to a horse, including, but not limited to, excessive spurring or whipping or excessive jerking of the reins is prohibited
- No unsound horses will be allowed to work
- Never bring a horse up to the house.
- Never have a horse on the yard around the house.
- Dogs are welcome but you must clean up after your dog and they are not allowed in pastures or arenas. It is your responsibility to make sure that it will not accidentally scare any horses or clients. Any dog who fails to comply with any of the rules will be subject to immediate termination of privileges at the sole discretion of the management.
- No yelling, running or loud music around the horses.
- Parents are responsible for all minor children. Don't leave children unattended or allow children to stand on the rails or gates.
- All gates shall be kept shut at all times, except while passing through. Please do not climb over gates, go through them.
- Absolutely no dumping anything on the premises, except in garbage container
- Horse trailer parking is available for an additional fee. Tack may be stored in the trailer, but Rosary Stables shall not be liable for the security of the tack or trailer. Trailer may not be accessible during wet or muddy weather.
- If you remove your horse from a field or paddock please return them to the same place when finished. Do not place your horse in a different area. If you have an emergency or cannot get your horse to their designated area then please contact the stable owner. Horses are separated into groups that Rosary Stables finds appropriate and mixing the groups could be dangerous to the handler or to the horse.
- All boarders that are having a professional visit the barn, such as a farrier, vet, chiropractor or any other scheduled visit for their horse, must let Rosary Stables know in advance to the visit. You must also remain on the premises while the visit is taking place. Do not leave until

the visit is complete and everyone has left the property. Boarders are responsible for picking up after any Equine Professional that is working on their horse.

- We recommend that halters be removed from horses in stalls and turn out areas.
- All horses must be washed in designated washing areas. Water hoses should be recoiled and faucets turned off tightly when you are finished.
- Every effort should be made to keep your horse under control at all times. Horses are not allowed to be turned loose outside of stalls in the barn, arenas, and paddock or pasture areas.
- Please park on gravel areas.
- Please do not help yourself to hay or bedding without asking Rosary Stables management first.

**If Stable Safety rules are not followed you may be asked to leave the Stable.**
